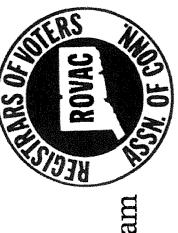

Board of Selectman+ Hello Southbury Residents,

I would have never imagined that I would be sharing news regarding a devastating flood that ravaged our community and turned Southbury into an Emergency Disaster Area overnight.

Southbury Emergency Management Director, Stephen Schnell, has been exemplary in his decision making and leadership during this immense emergency operation. During the initial two weeks after the flood, town departments worked as a team, day and night, to set up our Emergency Operations Center, set up the damage reporting tool, bring in disaster relief resources, open an emergency shelter, create a temporary space in Town for librarians to do their work and assist other departments, make temporary repairs to town roads and culverts to create access for as many roads as possible so that Region 15 schools could open their 2024-25 school year on-schedule. These efforts proved there are no silos within our departments. We are all in this together.

The Town set up a centralized Emergency Center-Flooding Information webpage to have all flood related resources and information accessible in one location. I urge citizens to go to that webpage for the most accurate and timely flood-related information. That link is https://www.southbury-ct.org/emergencycenter. The road closure map available there is updated as roads open and close. We have transitioned from daily flood updates to sharing updates once a week with any new information, going out on e-blasts and social media in real time. All of which gets saved on our website.

Southbury is resilient and a community that comes together in times of need as evidenced by the abundance of community support and previous events such as the tornado and covid. It will take time, but we will get through this.

#### Method 1. Copy the Resident Self-Report information into a Residential form

Tip: This will allow you to keep a record of the initial Resident Self-Report, in addition to transferring all of the info into the Residential form.
