"Relative to acquiring a copy of both registrar of voters certifications AND proof of annual training certificates if they were certified more than a year ago. Also, a copy of the Form ED-632 which certifies that the canvassing required by CT State Statute has been completed.."

In total there are twenty (17 plus the original 3) pages of responsive documents. Please forward \$10.00 for this request and the documents will be mailed to you.

C.G.S. sec. 1-210 Access to Public Records. Exempt Records.

Connecticut General Statutes section 1-210 (a) states, "Except as otherwise provided by federal law or state statute, all records maintained or keep on file by any public agency...shall be public records and every person shall have the right to (1) inspect such records promptly during regular office or business hours, (2) copy such records in accordance with subsection (g) of section 1-212, or (3) receive a copy of such records in accordance with section 1-212."

C.G.S. sec. 1-212 Copies and Scanning of Public Records. Fees.

Connecticut General Statutes section 1-212 (a) (b) – states inter alia, that any person applying in writing shall receive, promptly upon request, a plain ... copy of any public record, which cost shall not exceed fifty cents per page. §1-212 (formerly sec 1-15) Copies and Scanning of Public Records Fees., municipal agencies may charge a maximum of \$.50 per page for copies of responsive documents. You are also welcome to view these documents, should there be any, at no charge.

It is the Town of Vernon's policy to receive the payment of \$10.00 prior to the release of responsive documents.
